

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Learning About Quarter Hours

Did you know? The minute hand makes one full circle around the clock in 60 minutes (1 hour).

- When the minute hand points to 3, it's quarter past the hour (15 minutes past)
- When the minute hand points to 6, it's half past the hour (30 minutes past)
- When the minute hand points to 9, it's quarter to the next hour (45 minutes past)

Quarter past 3: Hour hand between 3 and 4, minute hand at 3

Half past 7: Hour hand between 7 and 8, minute hand at 6

Quarter to 9: Hour hand between 8 and 9, minute hand at 9
