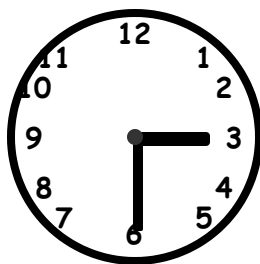
Part 8: Half Hour Times

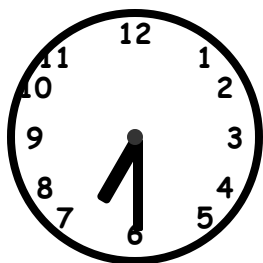
