Multi-digit Multiplication:

- $12 \times 3 = 36$
- $15 \times 4 = 60$
- $23 \times 2 = 46$
- $14 \times 5 = 70$
- $16 \times 3 = 48$
- $18 \times 2 = 36$

Advanced Arrays:

• Apples: 2 rows × 4 columns = 8

• Bananas: 3 rows × 3 columns = 9

Oranges: 2 rows × 3 columns = 6

Advanced Word Problems:

• Toy store: 14 boxes × 6 puzzles = 84 puzzles

• Lucy: 21 pages × 5 days = 105 pages

• Library: 7 shelves × 15 books = 105 books

• Classroom: 5 tables × 4 chairs = 20 chairs

• Gardener: 8 rows × 3 flowers = 24 flowers

• Mark: 10 packs × 2 pencils = 20 pencils
