1. You have 10 cookies. You eat 2, and then you bake 5 more. How many cookies do
you have now?
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2. There are 15 fish in a tank. You buy 5 more, but then you give 3 to a friend.
How many fish are left?
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3. A bus has 20 people. At the first stop, 5 people get off. At the second stop, 8
people get on. How many people are on the bus?
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4. Lily has 5 red marbles and 6 blue marbles. She loses 3 marbles. How many does she have left?

5. A farmer has 12 chickens. He sells 5 and then buys 10 more. How many chickens does he have?

15. Sam is taller than Mia. Mia is taller than Leo. Who is the shortest?
